Whole school year	Be kind	Quite simply, this is at the heart of everything William Booth. We set the foundations from the very start in Early Years and promote across all aspects of school life. We do this explicitly through stories, PSHE and our 'Global Citizenship' curriculum delivery as well as role modelling this quality every single day, by every adult with every child. Our annual Mental Health Week is based around this core value.
Autumn 1	Embrace challenge	Children start the school year with our 'Discover' theme, based around historical enquiry. They will learn how people of all backgrounds overcame the odds through sheer willpower, across a wide range of historical periods and in some of the most challenging circumstances.
Autumn 2	Earn respect	Through concepts such as 'power', 'pride' and 'freedom', children will consider how people in Nottingham, the UK and across the globe have made the world a better place. They will discover how individuals and groups have made a difference and been driven by their beliefs.
Spring	Live responsibly	In our 'Explore' theme, we focus on environment and sustainability. Children will assess the impact of their actions on the environment and understand the importance of protecting the world that we live in. They will study a range of countries and biomes to analyse the issue of sustainability and gain a sense of responsibility to make a difference.
Summer 1	Include others	Our final theme is 'Global Citizenship' with a focus on 'Belonging'. Children will learn about cultures and celebrations that bring people together. They will dissect some of the most important issues of our time and explore how concepts such as 'compassion', 'rights' and 'community' have shaped the world we live in.
Summer 2	Value difference	Children will appreciate how differences that make us unique are to be treasured. We prioritise diversity, equality, inclusion and belonging, allowing the children to be immersed in different societies and cultures. This will allow for deep understanding of how moral issues affect us all, and how acceptance and understanding can shape the world around us.
