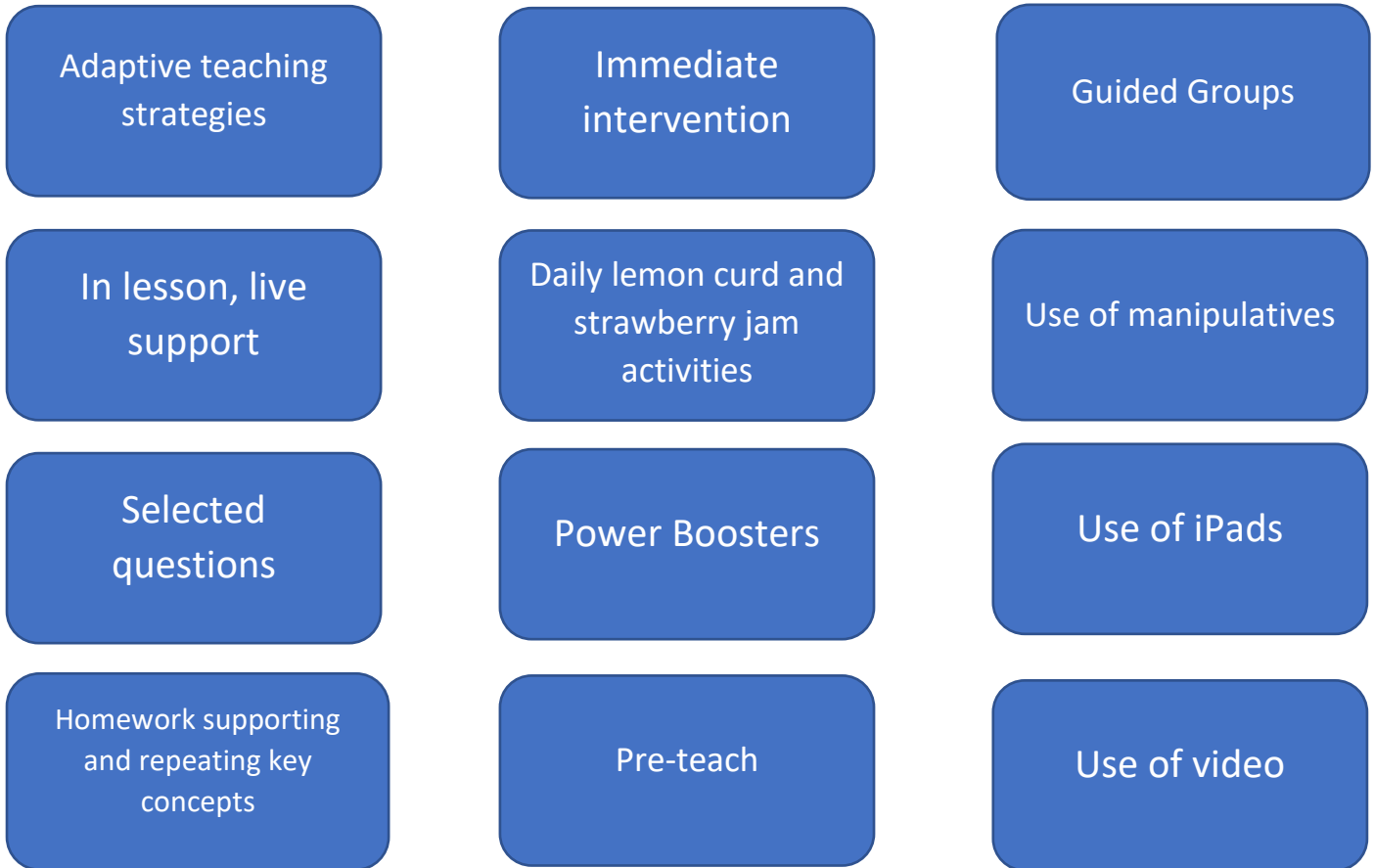


## SEND in Maths at William Booth Primary School



### Personalised Provision in Maths

In order to cater to the diverse learning needs of children operating at a level significantly below their peers, a personalised provision has been established to ensure targeted and effective support. Recognising the unique challenges these students may face, the teacher will conduct an initial assessment to identify key gaps in their knowledge. This personalised evaluation will serve as a crucial foundation for tailoring instruction to address specific areas of need. By strategically pinpointing the starting point for each child's educational journey, the personalised provision aims to foster a supportive and inclusive learning environment, nurturing the development of foundational skills and ensuring that every child can progress confidently through their educational milestones.

The personalised provision is then based on key themes:

- Daily warm up activities that recap and help retention of previous learning.
- Repetition of fundamentals needed to access the learning.
- Tailored iPad support- use of videos and online worksheets (WRM is often used to structure lessons ensuring that children can watch, re-watch and pause video explanations, alongside receiving input and support from staff members when appropriate)
- Opportunities for challenge
- Opportunities for talk
